Markers

KSHSAA requires the use of markers at all KSHSAA post-season tournaments. **We are asking each participating school with only one golfer participating to provide a marker for that group (either a coach or a qualified adult) and notify tournament officials at Cheney High School of that person's name by Wednesday, October 13th by 10:00 am.** This will help in coordination of tee times with markers. A marker meeting with all markers will take place prior to tee-time on state tournament day.

Spectator Guidelines

The golf gallery/spectator guidelines of the KSHSAA Golf 2010-2011 Manual, Page 12 and 17 will be enforced. Please make special notice that spectators are to stay at least 30 yards behind the group they are watching and remain on the cart path (this includes while they are on the green). Please review these guidelines with your spectators. Spectator golf carts will be available for rent for \$24.00 (18 holes) on a first come first serve basis Oct. 18th. **Carts may be reserved ahead through Cherry Oaks for \$40.00. Deadline to reserve a cart is Oct. 12th.** *Privately owned golf carts will not be permitted.*
