

## Kansas Qualified Admissions

**Admission Requirements** – To qualify for admission to any of the six Kansas Regents universities, you must meet one of the following requirements:

- Complete the pre-college or Kansas Scholars Curriculum with at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA); AND
- Achieve ONE of the following:  
ACT score of 21 or higher; OR  
SAT score of 980 or higher; OR  
Graduate in the top one-third of their class; AND
- Achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school

**Pre-college Curriculum** – One of the ways to meet university admission requirements is to successfully complete the pre-college curriculum as outlined by the Kansas Board of Regents. You must complete the curriculum as outlined with at least a 2.0 GPA (a “C” average) on a 4.0 scale.

The following outlines the high school courses that are required to meet the requirements for admission to any of the Kansas Regents universities. **Note: 1 unit = 1 year**

### English – 4 units required

At least one unit of English or communications must be taken each year of high school.

### Physical Science – 3 units required

Students must take three units chosen from the following courses: Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. At least one unit must be in chemistry or physics.

### Math – 3 units required

- Students must take one unit of each of Algebra I (IMP 1), Geometry (IMP 2), and Algebra 2 (IMP 3). Completion of any of the three required mathematics courses prior to entering high school satisfies the requirement for that course.
- Students are strongly encouraged to take a mathematics course every year of high school

### Social Sciences – 3 units required

- Students must complete the following: One unit of American History; One unit of American Government, and one unit of World Studies.

## Kansas Board of Regents Recommended Curriculum Kansas Scholar & CHS Valedictorians

As a Kansas high school graduate, you may be eligible for one of three state-sponsored scholarship programs.

- State Scholarship Program;
- Minority Scholarship Program;
- Kansas Teachers Scholarship. To be eligible for one of these scholarships, you must complete all the required courses for the precollege curriculum plus an additional three units, as follows:

Taking the curriculum is not a guarantee for scholarship as ACT scores and financial need do come into play. However, students are recognized for completing the curriculum and can earn possible scholarship money.

In order to be considered for Valedictorian status, a student must follow the recommended curriculum, which is outlined below.

### English – 4 units required

At least one unit of English or communications must be taken each year of high school.

### Physical Science

Students applying for the state-sponsored scholarship must take Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

### Math – 1 additional unit; total of 4 units required

In addition to IMP I, IMP II, IMP III, students are required to complete one unit of advanced mathematics. At CHS that choice would be IMP 4 or Calculus.

### Foreign Language – 2 units required

Students are required to complete two high school units in one foreign language.
